Include: 1 Title Slide + 10 slides = 11 total

Be sure to include:

- At least 10 slides
- Full Sentences
- At least 1 picture on each page of authentic work of art by the artist <u>but should not</u> take up more than 25% of the slide!
- DO NOT CUT AND PASTE the information!! (put it in your own words)
- Make it look good! Design a well composed slide for each topic
- Slide Topics to include:
 - 1. Title slide
 - 2. Which artist did you choose? Why? What drew you to this artist's work?
 - 3. The artist's basic information Name, year of birth/death, what country they're from , where they studied art, anything else interesting you find about the artist
 - 4. What is the medium they work in most (Ex. Oil paint, acrylic paint, clay, metal, etc.)? What style of art are they most known for? What it is called?
 - 5. Discuss this art style they are most known for (Ex. Impressionism, Classical, Minimalism, Pop Art, Photo-realism, etc.) What is it? What does it look like? What is it the inspiration/motivation? Why did it start or who started it?

6,7, 8 - Show three well-known works of art by your artist. One on each slide. Give title, year, and medium. Discuss and describe what we see. Then talk about what it is showing, what it means or represents, or why it's significant.

9, 10 - Name 2 other famous artists that work in that art style. One on each slide. Who are they and what are their famous works of art in that style that they're most known for? Give the artists name and title their work, give years and mediums, and an interesting fact about them or their work.

11. Conclusion - restate the artist, their style, the impact they had with their artwork, and something interesting you learned in doing this project.
